

Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held at Sugauli on 29th March,2026 at 2.30 PM

Attendance is attached as Annexure – 1

President granted leave of absence to Shree Atul Kumar Vice President, Dr Shipra Soni Vice –President and Jashu KUMari, Joint Secretary and Treasurer, Smt. Ajita Kumari, who were absent in the meeting because of some or other reasons.

He welcomed the members and thanked them for their active support for the development of Weightlifting in State. He mentioned that our progress is slowed down in the last two years. It is to be accelerated to achieve the desired goal. He informed that in the year some new units have been given recognition and affiliation. They are Khagaria , Nalanda, Aurangabad, Bihar State Sports Authority and Khelo India State Centre. President and Secretary of Khagria district Shree Prem Kumar Yaswant and Santosh kumar were introduced to house. President of Nalanda shree Arun Kumar Ojha and Treasurer Shree Roky Kumar and newly elected Secretary of Muzaffarpur Shree Dilmohan Jha were also introduced to the house. House welcomed all the new entrants. He also informed that Shree Pradyuman Kumar is Secretary of Nalanda district. Further he informed the house that General Secretary Shree Uupendra Kumar has tendered his resignation in June 2025. He was advised to continue till General Body meeting. In spite of request he is not ready to continue. Since last three months he denied to perform his duty. So, there is no option. We have to accept his resignation. We will take up this issue during discussion on Agenda. Wth above introductory remarks he again welcomed the members and declared the house in order and quorum is complete, so we could start with agenda.

Agenda item no,-1. To confirm the minutes of the last General Body meeting held on 23rd March,2025.

President informed that the minutes is available in the folder given to them. He mentioned that as per the minutes of last meeting, agenda no.- 6, our office was shifted in the month of March 2025. Shree Arun Kumar Kesri was requested by Shree Rajnish Bhaskar to provide space for shifting of office to Muzaffarpur. Now he has received a request to pay the house rent for additional period above three months @ Rs. 7,000/- per month.

House accepted the above legitimate request and decided to pay the rent for additional period till shifting .

President mentioned that there is no other remarks on the minutes so it may be approved.

Shree Mukesh Kumar proposed to confirm the minutes which was seconded by Shree Mukul Kumar and accepted by the house unanimously.

Resolution:- The minutes of last General Body meeting was confirmed with a decision to pay the rent to A,K.Kesri for office space occupied by Association for additional period @ Rs. 7,000/- per month.

Agenda item no.-2.- To adopt the Annual report presented by Hony. General Secretary

President mentioned that General Secretary is absent because of his resignation, So this agenda is deferred for next meeting. He mentioned that we could discuss his resignation.

Members suggested to accept his resignation which was accepted by the house.

He mentioned that now the post of General Secretary is vacant so, we must elect new General Secretary for remaining period of this term.

Shree Neeraj Kumar Roy, Secretary Bhagalpur proposed the name of Shree Girijesh Kumar, Secretary Jehanabad Distt. Weightlifting Association for the post of General Secretary Bihar Weightlifters' Association. House applauded and accepted this proposal. Shree Satish Kumar asked Shree Girijesh Kumar to come over the dais and occupy the Chair. Shree Girijesh Kumar, joined the dais. Members clapped and welcomed him as new General Secretary.

Resolution:- The agenda is deferred for next meeting. Resignation of Shree Upendra Kumar was accepted and Shree Girijesh Kumar was elected as new General Secretary.

Agenda item no.- 3. To approve and adopt the audited Statement of Account for the period 2024-2025.

President pointed out a typographic error in agenda of the meeting notice, so. in place of 25-26 it is to be read as 24-25. He further mentioned that Treasurer Mrs. Ajita Kumari is absent due to sickness of her father but she has sent the Audited Statement of Account which is placed in given folder.

Shree Satish Kumar mentioned that she is absent during the Cadet State Championships and also not attending meeting since long. So her post should also be treated as vacant. President mentioned that there is very clear clause in our constitution at Clause 10. None of the Sub-clause is applicable to her. So, she will continue till remaining period of the Tenure.

President asked the members to raise points if any.

Shri Arvind kumar of Nawada raised regarding receipt of grant from BSSA. President mentioned that some of grant received for 22-23 and 23-24 session which was applied earlier, spent and received in financial year 24-25.

Shree Satish Kumar mentioned regarding the legal expense. President explained that a case was filled against Shree Arun Kumar Kesri. This case was filled because Rishika Raj has not been posted as Referee by the Association. So, it was decided to bear the legal expenses by the Association.

President asked the members to raise points (if any) regarding Audited Statement of Account. As there was no point raised by any member, Shree Santosh Kumar of Khagaria proposed to approve and adopt the Audited Statement of Account for the period 24-25, which was seconded by Md. Rustam Alam of East Champaran and accepted by the House unanimously.

Resolution:- The Audited Statement of Account for the period 2024-25 was approved and adopted.

Agenda item no.- 4. To allot the different State Championships to the districts.

President mentioned that earlier we were holding Youth, Junior and Senior State Championships separately in different districts. But, now Federation is organising all the three Championships together at one place. So, falling in line with Federation, we will also organize all the three championship at one place.

Further he mentioned that there are two Championships is to be allotted to districts i.e. Cadet State Weightlifting Championships are to be allotted.. The districts interested to organize the championship may tender their proposal.

Shree Mukesh Kumar offered to hold Cadet State Championship in Bhojpur district. Members applauded his proposal.

Shree Himanshu Kumar representative Begusarai offered to hold the Youth, Junior and Senior Championship at Begusarai.

President mentioned that he is not competent enough to offer such proposal. He will talk to President/Secretary of Begusarai to take final decision on the issue.

Resolution:- 4th Cadet State Weightlifting Championships was allotted to Bhojpur district. Venue of Youth Junior and Senior Championships will be decided very shortly.

Agenda item no.- 5. - To discuss the position of activity in the Districts.

President mentioned that earlier in 2025 we were allotted 3 Asmita Womens City league being organized in Jehanabad, Sitamarhi and Gopalganj. Later on three more was allotted to Bihar which was allotted to Bhagalpur , Sugauli and Bhojpur but after organization, submission of bills was very much delayed. We received several reminders from Federation for submission of bills and vouchers. The delay in submission of Bills affects the image Of State Association.

In the year 2026 we may organize Asmita league in 20 more districts. Considering the failure of districts in submission of bill we may consider to appoint an Event management team to organize the Asmita league in all the 20 districts.

Shree Rustam Alam opposed this proposal and said that it will affect and deteriorate the interest of the district. Some other members were also of the same opinion. After discussion it was decided to continue the system adopted earlier. Name of the probable Districts will be decided by President and Secretary in due course after receipt of final letter and allotment from the Federation.

Resolution:- Position was noted by the house

Agenda item no.- 6. To discuss regarding the conduct of Talent search.

President informed the house that when we launched the Talent Search Program in the year 2022, it was planned to cover whole state within 3 years. But, in the year 24 & 25 we could not conduct the same due to instruction from D.G. BSSA. But we have submitted our ACTC (Annual Calendar for Training and Competition) for 26-27 with a proposal to conduct the same in rest of 14 districts. So, this year the Talent Search will be conducted in rest of the 14 Districts.

Resolution :- House noted the proposal.

Agenda item no. – 7. (Supplementary Agenda) Amendment in constitution with proposed amendments.

President briefed the situation in the house for urgent change and amendments in constitution. The Govt. of India has enforced New Sports Policies under which Federation, State Sports Association and even District Association is also covered. Federation has issued a circular with highlighted points where the amendment in Constitution is mandatory within three months of receipt of circular. This is why we included the Agenda- "Amendment in Constitution" as supplementary agenda. The amendments required was sent to the members as "Proposed amendments" and also placed in the folder given to the members.

Members said that as it is mandatory amendment there is no point for discussion. Shree Rustam Alam mentioned that it will be difficult for district to fall in line with same, because right now we are facing difficulty in organization and lack of dedicated and interested people in the district.

Shree Mukul Kumar of Gopalganj proposed to approve and adopt the proposed amendments which was seconded by Shree Arvind Kumar of Nawada and accepted by the house unanimously.

Resolution:- The proposed amendment was approved and adopted by the house.

Agenda item no.- 8. Any other item with permission of the Chair.

1. Shree Rustam Alam mentioned that 27 referees were posted for 3rd Cadet State Championships. Out of which only 15 Referees reported for the Championships. Which created problem for organiser and present Referees too. They have to do double duty without break. He proposed to take action against those Referees who failed to report without prior information and permission . Shree Arun Kumar Kesri proposed to debar those Referees for one year and they should not be posted as Referee for any of the Competition for one year from the date of this decision. Shree Satish Kumar seconded the proposal of Mr. Kesri and House accepted the same unanimously.
2. Shree Satish Kumar proposed to make the validity of the I.Card issued by the Association life long in place of 3 years because Federation is also issuing I.Card with life time validity. He further mentioned that Shree Rajnish Bhaskar has sent the same proposal in the group. Shree Arun Kumar Ojha replied that Federation is making I.D. cards at age of 15/16 years where as we are issuing the card at the age of 8 years. We are the only State to do the same. A discussion was also taken place in the last AGM where it was decided to issue the card for five years and Registration fee to be charged as Rs.300/- Districts may collect Rs.500/- from per athlete as Registration Fee and send Rs.300/- to State Association.
3. Shree Mukul Kumar proposed that we are giving Trophy to Champion team only. The Runners' Up team should also be provided the Runners' Up Trophies. Shree Girijesh Kumar proposed that Shree Roky Kumar, Treasurer Nalanda district is ready to Sponsor the three Trophies for Cadet State Championships. Shree Roky Kumar accepted the proposal and mentioned that he will provide 3 trophies before 4th State Championships.
4. Shree Satish Kumar mentioned that in National Championship a separate medal and trophy is awarded for Open National and State. In Bihar also some Institutional Members have been granted affiliation, So, the same process should be started in Bihar also. President assured to do the needful. As there was no any other item Shree Girijesh Kumar thanked Chair and meeting was ended.
